



**DRAFT Minutes**  
**Board of Directors Meeting**  
**September 9, 2013**

- I. Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by President Dave Bushey at 7:35 pm. The meeting was held in the law offices of Allred, Bacon, Halfhill & Young. - A. Sept, Oct, Nov Preliminary Review of Expenses and Encumbrance thereof – Insurance was voted on last month, due in October; November will have \$525 due as balance on rental of facilities for Holiday Party. Kathy Norris made the motion to authorize the expenditure of \$525 for balance due on rental of facilities for the Holiday Party, Mark Hendrickson seconded the motion, motion carried. Dave presented contracts from each, and their (Dave, Marcia, Pam) collected comments on each site. Much discussion. Discussion, motion amended by Angie Bushey to continue negotiating with Dulles Hyatt, amended motion carried.

Mark pointed out on the Music Committee, NVSC no longer has a 'Corporation DJ', the 'Communications Committee' is not named, just a little more refinement needed in committee area of bylaws, excepting Dance Committee.
