Due to the efforts of BARBARA TAYLOR of the Roanoke Valley Shag Club, we each have the exciting opportunity to own a SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATE representing the Shag Clubs of Virginia.

Unless we act QUICKLY, however, this chance may be lost! Presently, 150 applications, accompanied by a \$10 check to DMV are required before the plates can be issued; Barbara says she now has 100 applications. New regulations may soon require 1,000 or more applications before specialty plates can be issued, if at all!

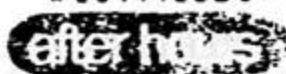

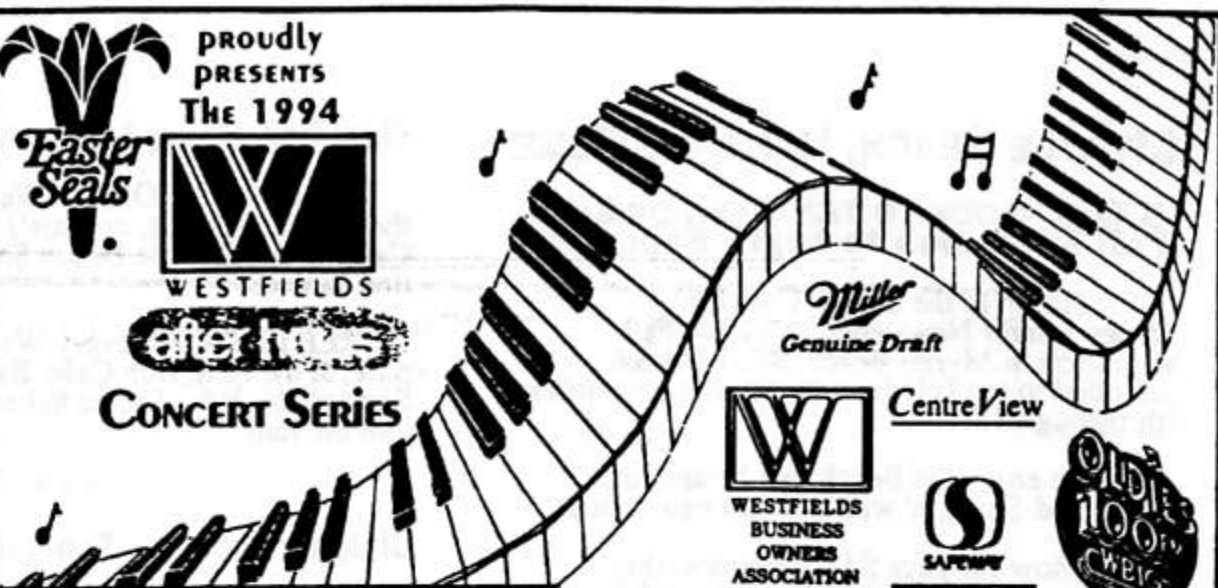
