From the President - By Charlie Price

On Saturday, February 25, Janis, John and I attended the Winter Workshop for our national association -- the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs (ACSC) -- in Mooresville, NC, where we learned quite a few things of interest to our Club.

First, the numbers, which are somewhat mind boggling in and of themselves..... As of this meeting there are more than 100 Clubs in the ACSC with more than 15,000 (yes, that's not a typo--more than 15,000 members!) In addition:

SOS Chairman Bob Wood spoke in defense of the increase in the SOS membership fee from \$25 to \$35 effective the first of this year. This fee covers 23 days(!) of SOS partying (Mid-Winter Party, Spring Safari and Fall Migration), and is approximately the same as the cost of most Shag club weekends. Moreover, most of the additional revenues raised by this increase will come back to the ACSC.

Apparently some disgruntled folks have talked about a "boycott" of Spring SOS because of the increase, saying they will just pay the (old) \$5 door charge and stay in one club all day long. I suspect that this is all "news" to our Club members, but if you know someone who plans to try this, be advised that this year every major club owner will be charging \$10 per head every time you come through the door -- and only \$5 of that \$10 will be remitted to SOS. So, don't "cut off your nose to spite your face." SOS is owned by ACSC and virtually all of the profits generated by SOS come back to ACSC and, indirectly, to you as a member of an ACSC club.

As of February, and for the first time, all the major Carolina Shag associations -- the local Shag Clubs, the Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame Foundation, the Competitive Shaggers Assn., the Association of Beach & Shag Club DJs, and the Shag Preservation Assn. (the Myrtle Beach Club owners) -- are finally united under a common front -- ACSC! This can only mean bigger and better things for us, and this dance and lifestyle that we all love!

Keep on Shaggin', and see you at Deja Vu!

MEDICAL ALERT: Peculiar Syndrome Spreads to D.C. -- by Patricia Parrott

Modern medical scientists are closely monitoring peculiar occurrences in the Washington, D.C. area around Springfield, VA, extending to LaPlata, MD, with a couple of cases identified in NJ and NY. SOS Spring Safari

April 21-30 in North Myrtle Beach, S.C.

It's that time of year again, Shaggers --time to head for Spring Safari at N. Myrtle Beach, S.C., for ten full days of sun, fun, beach, party party, and dance, dance, dance as long as your feet and legs hold up!

For those of you who have not yet gone to S.O.S., it is the best time you could ever imagine. Where else would you find 10,000 people dancing, partying and generally having a ball, in one place, at one time -- and all because of a regional dance called the Shag? That's right -- for ten days each spring and fall, Shaggers from all over the country flock back to Ocean Drive in North Myrtle Beach to celebrate and perpetuate the best party in the world -- S.O.S.

The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs hosts these events by the Society of Strangers (S.O.S.), named after the 35-mile stretch of beach along the South Carolina coast called the Grand Strand.
