This was the North Carolina Alumni Association Spring Beach Bash. We enjoyed informal dancing on a beautiful floor to great beach music, light snacks, good socialization, sharing steps and fun.

Wanna Play? You Gotta Pay . . .

Now that we've had a few weeks to adjust and settle in to our new location, it seems timely to mention a "fact of life" that sometimes seems to escape us.

In the last month, we have heard the sad news that two sister Shag Clubs have lost their dance floor on Sunday nights from lack of participation. The Fredricksburg Shag Club has lost the opportunity to dance at the Underground on Sunday nights, but has moved to another location on Wednesday nights. And the Richmond Shag Club, which regularly meets on Tuesday nights, has given up the use of Razzles on Sunday afternoons, due to lack of support by the membership. RSC will, however, host a Sunday Social at Razzles on the 3rd Sunday of each month, beginning on May 21st.

We are very fortunate to have our lovely new "home" at Deja Vu. It is large enough to accommodate many, many more Shaggers and friends; it is in a good location, and is easy to find; they have gone out of their way to accommodate us -- plans in the near future include refinishing and expanding the already large wooden dance floor; Wednesday nights are dedicated to our Shag Club and Beach Music, even though we are not large enough for a "private party"; and, the cover charge is only \$2.00. That is a small price to pay in this D.C. metropolitan area to enter a dance club with such a pleasant environment where you can socialize and dance with great people.

Other dance clubs in this area charge a much higher cover -- \$5 or even \$10 is not unusual. They have to, in order to stay in business! It seems that serious dancers generally do not drink enough to support the establishment that is supporting their activity. But it is not necessary to buy alcohol, if you don't want to drink and dance. Buy soft drinks, or juice -- they stock a variety of juices at the bar that are delicious and healthy. Go early and buy dinner or a light snack. Blackie's is an excellent restaurant, and they'll serve you right at the bar!

The important thing to remember is to buy something -- anything -- to pay your share toward keeping that dance floor. The bartender and the DJ are there working to earn a living! They are not volunteers who are there just to hang around with us. Please remember to thank them with a tip, and SPEND MONEY.

A dance floor represents a large investment that must earn a profit, or it will cease to exist. Blackie's has to make a profit to stay in business, that's a "fact of life." If all the income is being generated by the CW's on the "other side," and the Shaggers are not spending enough to make it worthwhile to open

Deja Vu, pay a doorman, a bartender and a DJ -- guess what will happen?

Support your Club -- come on out on Wednesday nights to Shag and party with your friends at DEJA VU. And remember, if you wanna play, you gotta pay.
