The Life and Death of a Dance Floor.....(or, You Wanna Play? You Gotta Pay. . .)

Recently, there were two important events in the life of our club -- our first "Dance Party"; and participation by local and out-of-town shaggers in the Virginia State Open Dance Competitions. The limited turnout by our membership for both of these events brings to mind a "fact of life" that sometimes seems to escape us . . . if you wanna play, you gotta pay....

In the past year we have heard the sad news that two sister shag clubs lost their dance floors due to lack of participation and support by their own memberships. And we've seen other local dance clubs struggle to find a new place to dance after losing their space -- often with little or no warning.

We are very fortunate to have our "home" at Deja Vu. The space is large enough to accommodate a very large crowd of shaggers and friends; it is in a good location, convenient for most people and easy to find; Wednesday nights -- and now Sunday nights!! -- are dedicated to our Shag Club and Beach Music (and this is the *only* place this is happening in the entire area, folks); and the cover charge is only \$2.00. That is a small price to pay in this D.C. metropolitan area to enter a dance club with such a pleasant environment. You can socialize and dance with great people, and single ladies can go there and feel safe.

Other dance clubs in this area charge a much higher cover -- \$5 or even \$10 is the usual. They have to, in order to stay in business! It seems that dancers generally do not drink or spend enough money to support the establishment that is supporting their activity. But it is not necessary to buy alcohol, if you don't want to drink and dance. Buy soft drinks, or juice -- they stock a variety of juices at the bar that are delicious and healthy. Go early and buy dinner or a light snack. Blackie's is an excellent restaurant, and they'll serve you right at the bar in Deja Vu!

A dance floor represents a large investment that must earn a profit, or it will cease to exist. Blackie's has to make a profit to stay in business, that's a "fact of life." If most of the income is being generated by the CW's on the "other side," and the shaggers are not spending enough to make it worthwhile to open Deja Vu and pay a doorman, a bartender and a DJ -- what do you think will happen?

The important thing to remember is to buy something -- anything -- to pay your share toward keeping that dance floor. The bartender and the DJ are there working to earn a living. They are not volunteers who are there just to hang around with us. Please remember to thank them with a tip, and SPEND MONEY.

Support your club -- come on out on Wednesdays and Sundays to shag and party with your friends at DEJA VU. And remember, if you wanna play, you gotta pay.

Intermediate Shag Lessons

with

Okay, so you've learned the shag basic, the male and female underarm turn, a mirror step or two, and you're working on getting that pivot down . . . now what? Where do you go to learn more?

Here's an idea: **Starting Nov. 5th, NVSC will offer Intermediate shag lessons from 5-6 p.m. on Sundays at Deja Vu.** This class is an outgrowth of the earlier, free intermediate classes that used to be offered on Wed. nights. Because of the growing size of that group, the time and attention required to learn new steps, and NVSC's need to raise funds for club activities, the format has evolved into something new. Now the class will be a four-week course. We will meet for a full hour each Sunday at a time when there are no competing distractions. This new format will allow for more time and room to practice and master each step, and to get all of your questions answered. Because this class meets on a different night of the week, you can expect to see your dancing improve faster, as you get out there and shag two nights a week, instead of one.

After much (much!) discussion, we have decided to charge a small fee of \$15 per person, or \$25 per couple, for each four-week course. The instructors for the class will donate their time to the club, so 100% of this money will go to your club's treasury.

The Intermediate Shag Class will cover eight new steps (four mirror patterns and four leadable steps, plus some variations), but will also stress form and technique. You'll get tips to make your dancing smoother and more shag-like. **To sign up, just show up early, before the first class on Nov. 5th.**

Come and join us -- it'll be fun!

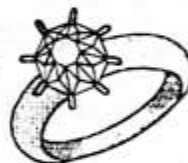
