# SOS

## The First Time

by the Virgin Trippers

SOS was undoubtedly the biggest and best five-day party ever attended by the virgin trippers -- Vesta Jones, Donna Leibowitz, Trelle Shaw, Linda Shingleton (Trelle's NC friend) and Karen Wagley. We expected a good time, but our first SOS far exceeded our dreams. If you've never been to SOS you've got to begin making plans for your virgin trip NOW -- we all agreed that we'll be returning as experienced SOSers in September.

### Trippin'

In anticipation of all the fun, Trelle suggested renting a car with a huge trunk so we could party together all the way down to Myrtle Beach. 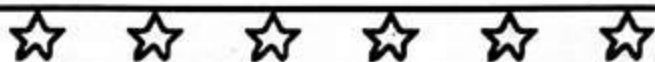

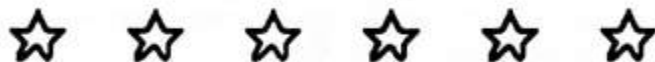
