The Life and Death of a Dance Floor...... (or, You Wanna Play? You Gotta Pay)

SHAGGERS — you know who you are — you need to come out on Wednesday nights to shag and party with your friends at Deja Vu. Recently, we have seen a decrease in attendance by our regular members on Wednesday nights, which brings to mind a "fact of life" that sometimes seems to escape us . . . if you wanna play, you gotta pay....

In the past we've heard the sad news of sister shag clubs losing their dance floors due to lack of participation and support by their own memberships. And we've seen other local dance clubs struggle to find a new place to dance after losing their space -- often with little or no warning.

We are fortunate to have our "home" at Deja Vu. The space is large enough to accommodate a very large crowd of shaggers and friends; it is in a good location, convenient for most people and easy to find; Wednesday nights are dedicated to our Shag Club and Beach Music (this is the only place where this is happening in the entire area, folks); and the cover charge is only \$2.00. That is a small price to pay in the D.C. Metropolitan Area to enter a dance club with such a pleasant environment. You can socialize and dance with great people, and single ladies can go there and feel safe.

Other dance clubs in this area charge a much higher cover -- \$5 or even \$10 is the norm. They have to, in order to stay in business! It seems that dancers generally do not drink or spend enough money to support the establishment that is supporting their activity. But it is not necessary to buy alcohol, if you don't want to drink and dance. Buy soft drinks, or juice -- Deja Vu offers a variety of juices at the bar that are delicious and healthy. Go early and buy dinner or a light snack; Blackie's is an excellent restaurant, and they'll serve you right at the bar in Deja Vu!

A dance floor represents a large investment that must earn a profit, or it will cease to exist. Blackie's has to make a profit to stay in business, that's a "fact of life." The bartender, Deejay and other employees are there working to earn a living. They are not volunteers who are there just to hang around with us. If most of the income is being generated by the patrons on the "other side" and the kids on the weekend -- and the shaggers are not spending enough to make it worthwhile to open Deja Vu and pay a doorman, a bartender and a Deejay -- what do you think will happen?

The important thing is to COME OUT and SUPPORT YOUR CLUB; buy something -- anything -- to pay your share toward keeping that dance floor. And remember, if you wanna play, you gotta pay.

Shagging Tips

- Listen to the Beat of the Music, and <u>Step On</u> <u>The Beat</u>.
- Shag is danced on a slot in a back-and-forth movement, not in a circular movement. Imagine that your hand is on a post and you're moving toward and away from it.
- · Take SMALL STEPS for better control.
- Body movement is basically from the waist down, with knees slightly bent. Do not bounce!
 Glide -- as if on skates.

Completing the team are Grayson Smith & Jessica McAlhany and Bill & Brenda Barber from South Carolina.
