So, reluctantly, I said to my shaggin' half, Audrey, "You go to the workshop without me, and maybe later in the evening at the Sheraton dance you can show me the new steps."

Off we went in two different directions with two different tasks to accomplish -- I was going to build fishing habitats for the fishing club I belong to, and Audrey was off to learn the new dance steps taught by the National Shag Champions, Sam and Sarah West. Since my arm was in a cast, I did not know how much help I would be to my fishing club (but a commitment is a commitment). Also, since I had to miss the dancing workshop, I tried to convince myself I would not have fun anyway -- again because of my cast. So, I brushed the regrets aside and did what I had to do -- make homes for poor little fishes. But, believe me. . . I wished I could be at Blackie's learning the new steps from the National Champs. Oh well, I thought, at least I could watch them dance that night.

Later that night, Audrey talked my head off on the way to the Sheraton Hotel. She went on and on saying how well Sam and Sarah West danced together. When we arrived at the Sheraton, things were really in a super dance mode; the DJ was playing the music non-stop; the beat of the rhythm was great; and, there were dancers everywhere. Needless to say, I felt the groove of the music and tried to dance, cast and all. Audrey, bless her heart, tried to deal with my cast, which not only covered my arm, but also my hand. Doing turns with it on was painful for me. I notice Audrey's fingers were getting banged up from my cast and we decided to sit down and nurture "our wounds" and just watch people dance.

Lo and behold, Sarah West walked up to us. Audrey introduced me to the "1996 National Shag Champion." I was impressed! Sarah smiled and said, "Pleased to meet you, Don, and -- my goodness, what did you do to your hand?" Trying to be cool, I said, "Audrey would not let go of my hand when we did a super pivot." Sarah laughed. She seemed to enjoy my humor. Then I told her the truth about my dumb accident trying to start my lawnmower and ending up with the broken bone in my hand. I also told her how inhibited I was in doing certain turns in our dance. I said to

Sarah, "I guess I just feel kind of down -- not being able to "strut my stuff like a fine Carolina peacock" (*yeah Don, like you're really in full plume. . . but, at least I've mastered the rock step and know how to act cool -- which is shagger's trait*). No sooner did I finish my coc. act, than Audrey said to Sarah, "Dance with Don." I said, "You've got to be kidding! I'm barely in the intermediate class of our club," (I definitely blew my coolness in desperation) "and my arm is in a cast, and. . . and. . ." Sarah said, "Your foot is not in a cast." Well, we got out on the dance floor and, needless to say, I was in heaven. . . shagging NOT under a Carolina moon, BUT with a Carolina STAR! Sarah said, "Shaggers will always find a way to dance, and see. . . here we are. . . let's pivot!" Boy! Was I on Cloud 9 -- or should I say Clouds 1&2, 3&4, 5, 6.

There in one brief moment, in less than the three minutes it takes to play a record, Sarah West displayed what a "Champion" she is. A Champion, not only on the dance floor, but off the dance floor as well. I was struck by her demeanor -- it was true to the characteristics of the shagging tradition. She was, of course, friendly and poised, with a truly genuine grace, had a generous smile, and a natural all encompassing Southern charm. Call it shag protocol, or Carolina etiquette, but it was the inherent authenticity that came across to me -- integrity, respect, and enthusiasm -- personal traits that are unassuming in shaggers -- for the dance itself and for a dance partner, individual styles, or coolness-beginner or "pro." And, although I didn't get to watch Sarah and Sam perform that evening, I am so excited that I got to dance with a Champion! And, more importantly, my impression of Sarah was that she is not only a Champion of the Shag, but she has the heart of a Champion, too. . . Yes, in my book, Sarah West, "You are one fine Southern Lady!"

We stayed at the Sheraton until after midnight. Audrey and I said good-bye to our fellow club members and down the elevator we went. Things were still jumping as we went out the door of the Sheraton to our car. Once we got out on Rt. 395 heading home, Audrey started talking about how much fun we had. . . only I noticed the tone of her voice was different. . . it was the way she pronounced her words. . . she spoke melodically, with a sort of "charming Southern drawl!" Talk about being cool! Well, I did meet her in the southern part of Virginia Beach. . . y'all!

On Saturday, May 10th, John Belt, Charlie Price and I visited our dance floor to survey its current condition in preparation for the Capital Shag Classic. *Unfortunately, we found that we had LOST our storage facility(!) and the floor was at EXTREME RISK!!* It was apparent that we needed to retrieve the floor at once.

On Sunday, May 11th, John Belt, his son-in-law Peter and grandson Zach, Dave Rapson, Valerie Swiger and I picked up the floor (in three truck loads) and transported it to safety. It is currently in temporary storage in Fairfax until the CSC.

We are in **DESPERATE** need of a safe place to store the floor. Can YOU help? Not a lot of space is needed -- the floor will store in a footprint space of about 4' by 8' by 9' high. If you think you can help, **CALL ME** -- Home: 703-425-2848; Work: 703-730-1818.

The floor is a valuable club asset. We have about \$1,500 invested in this floor, and it behooves us to protect it and re-use it. For those of you who are curious, it costs about \$2,300 to rent an equivalent size floor (not including labor) for the Classic. The economic consequences should be obvious. **GET INVOLVED!**
