The pavers are for sale.

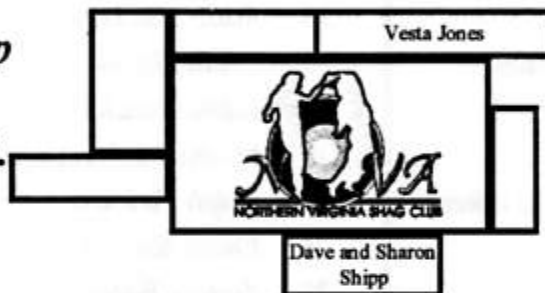
The 16" x 16" is \$600. Our club hopes to buy one of these.
