



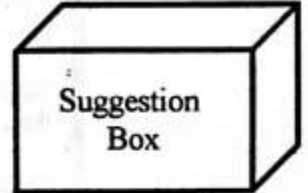

ADVANCED SHAG LESSONS!

Rejoice, Shaggers, your prayers have been answered... starting on Sunday, **October 4th**, shaggers wanting to advance their dancing will have the opportunity to meet each and **EVERY SUNDAY** at Lulu's from 5-8 p.m. to share steps, learn new steps, and practice. **An advanced class will begin promptly at 6 p.m.**, allowing time for dancers at our Sunday Social in Manassas to attend both functions.

At the same time we welcome participation by **JUNIORS** and **YOUNG ADULTS** wanting to learn to shag and practice.

The cost will be \$5 per person (which will go into our club treasury); **EXCEPT** that juniors and young adults (through age 25!) are encouraged to attend for **FREE!**

Sunday afternoons are traditionally a time for families, with children, at Blackie's, so there should be no problem bringing in youngsters to Lulu's at that time.

These advanced classes and practice sessions are scheduled not to conflict with our regular monthly Sunday Social, which lasts from 2-5 p.m. on the 3rd Sunday of every month.

Remember -- **Sunday October 4th** -- 5 p.m. -- Lulu's -- advance your dancing.... practice with friends..... help to teach juniors and young adults..... see you there!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NOVEMBER 1998 NVSC ELECTION

Each year in November, NVSC members elect 4 officers and 5 directors-at-large to serve as the 9-person NVSC Board of Directors for the following calendar year. All NVSC members in good standing (those who have paid dues for the current year) may vote in the November election for their choice of officers and directors-at-large. Members may vote either in person on election night or by mail-in-ballot.

Under current NVSC bylaws and operating procedures, a 7-member Nominating and Elections Committee -- hereafter referred to as the Nominating Committee -- is preparing a list of candidates for the 1999 Board. Candidates have indicated to the Nominating Committee that they are willing to:

- [1] be nominated for an officer or director-at-large position;
- [2] prepare a one-paragraph resume statement that explains to the membership how and why the candidate is qualified and wants to serve on the Board; and
- [3] carry out both the general duties and the specific duties of the officer or director-at-large position to which they may be elected, as described in NVSC bylaws.

Our bylaws require that candidates for the Secretary, Treasurer, and director-at-large positions must have been a NVSC member for at least one year, and candidates for President and Vice President must have served on the Board for at least one year (and thus have been a NVSC member for at least two years).

Any NVSC member who wants to volunteer for an officer or director-at-large position, or wishes to nominate a fellow NVSC member for the Board, should contact one of the following members of the Nominating Committee as soon as possible. They will gladly answer any questions you have about the nomination and election process.

- Oct. 28: Nominating Committee presents names to members at the quarterly meeting
- Oct. 28: Nominating Committee accepts other nominations from the floor
- Nov. 4: Nominating Committee publishes names and resumes of all nominees
- Nov. 18: Mail-in ballots to NVSC Secretary must be postmarked
- Nov. 18: Election night at Blackies
- Dec. 2: Election results announced (except for tie-vote runoff election, if needed)
- Dec. 12: Tie-vote runoff election, if needed, and tie-vote election results announced

They have added center islands and planted trees and have added PAVERS to the sidewalks.

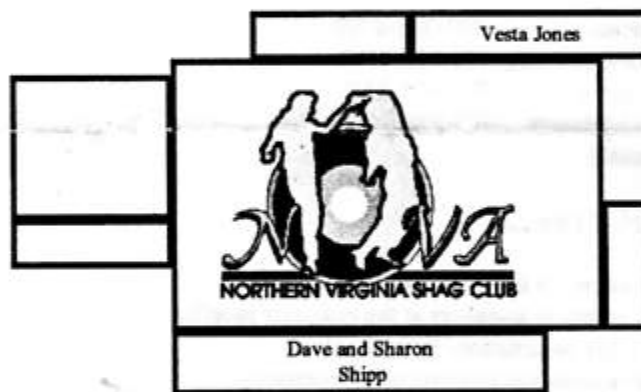
The pavers are for sale.

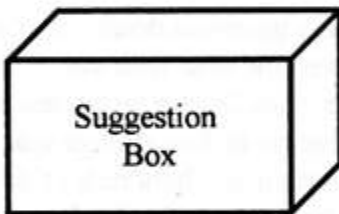
This column will be devoted to the **ROOKIES**.
