## Bylaws

In drafting our current Bylaws, our founding members borrowed from other clubs, principally Richmond. Now our club has its own experiences, and the proposed revision of the Bylaws is an effort to match our Bylaws to our own programs and needs.

Your help is greatly appreciated.

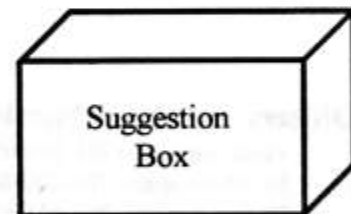
### Thank You VESTA
