Did you know that the NVSC has a record/music producer in our midst? A lot of our new shag club members may not know that there is a Washington native who has dedicated his work efforts to the musical side of the dance world. A long-time member of the Northern Virginia Shag Club, **MARC FISHER** now lives in Florida most of the year, but stays in close touch with our club, through the newsletter and his many friends here.

Music is the basis of all the diversity of dance in our area -- but to shaggers, none is more important than our beloved R&B/beach music. Beach music CDs are an essential part of the unbroken circle in the preservation of beach music and shag dance.

Thankfully, producers like Marc, through his Beach Bag label, continue to produce and distribute dance compilations of beach music, in many cases prepitched to fit our style of dance. Two of Marc's latest releases, **Blues on the Loose**, and **Full Measure of Blues III**, feature a solid combination of classic R&B, neo-disco, and contemporary blues. Blues on the Loose even showcases Lulu's and NVSC shaggers -- the front and back covers were shot at Lulu's (at Blackie's; our home base of several years at the time of its release.).

Best of all, Blues on the Loose (check out "**Statesboro Blues**" and "**See About Me**"), and Full Measure of Blues III (check out "**Think**" and "**She's Sixty**") are available through our own music vendor, **Gerry Scott**, at Nick's on Wednesday nights, as well as Judy's House of Oldies in North Myrtle Beach.

Dancing on the Diving Board

"Dancing on a diving board" is another one of the basic principles of shagging, related to last month's topic, "Dancing in the Slot." There we said that dancing in the slot means that the partners dance up and back in a very straight line when doing the basic step. The triple steps and rock step are all done within a very narrow vertical space.

As we noted, over the years shag has "straightened out" and lateral movement in the basic has been dropped. This contributes to the dance's smoothness and subtlety that is uniquely shag.

"Dancing on a diving board" means that when executing turns the partners stay close to each other... so close that they could actually execute the turns on the narrow width of a diving board. And of course, they dance up and back in a slot, as they would have to if they were dancing on a diving board.

Nowhere can this be illustrated better than in the simple female turn. On the "1 & 2" the couple should be "back to front" (female's back to the male's front) in a close parallel position. Each person ends up on the other person's spot on the floor. Done properly, this turn could easily be executed on a diving board!

Until next month, *keep on shagging.*

Well, SOS is "beach week" for adults. 10 full days of dancing, sun and friends. There are nine bars in a three block area of North Myrtle Beach that open their doors to thousands of Shaggers twice each year, **April and September**. You buy a yearly SOS Badge, cost **\$35.00**. You carry it with you from bar to bar and this eliminates the cover charges. You dance as much or as little as you want. You have a chance to take Shag lessons from the top shaggers. You are even offered free food, at some of the bars, if you are at the bar when they are offering it.

First thing upon arrival to North Myrtle Beach, get an **SOS Badge**. You will see tents set up on Main Street that sell the badges. *(During January and February, this club sells the badges for a discount.)*

Second: pick up a SOS Newspaper, this is a newspaper written about SOS, in it you will find a list of the classes, competitions and "free stuff".

Third: put on your most comfortable dance shoes and start having fun.

- SOS Badge
