Throughout this newsletter and at Nicks are the registration forms and additional details you'll need to get a hotel room, attend the Classic, play in the golf tournament, be part of the teams that make the Classic happen, and generally enjoy yourself. **A summary:**

GOLF TOURNAMENT: Registration deadline for the tournament is earlier than the Classic itself. We must give Ft. Belvoir a headcount by **June 20**; and so we need your names -- and your money, please (**\$65** payable to NVSC, covering golf and lunch and prizes) -- before that. See **Joe Cornish, Laura Lightbourne** and/or the flyers... Sign-up sheet at Nicks for a volunteer team at the golf course: registration desk, scorekeeper, setting out signs and banners, monitoring the hole-in-one contest... Make the hole-in-one and you'll win a car. Other prizes for longest drive, closest to the pin, etc... Music and shagging at the tournament lunch. Haven't lost sight that this is a shag club, and here's a chance to show off shag to some (current) non-shaggers..And some of our tournament profits will go to **Hospice** for its compassionate work.

THE HOTEL: Deadline is **June 22** for shag club rate (**\$79**, up to 4 people in a room). Call (703)548-6300...Don't get confused. There are two Holiday Inns in the Old Town Alexandria area. Ours is at the upper end of Old Town --- **Holiday Inn Hotel and Suites at 625 First St.**

THE CLASSIC WEEKEND: **\$55** per ticket until **June 22**. **\$60** after that. Send to NVSC, P.O. Box 5522, McLean, VA. 22103. ... Good deal. \$55 covers the free pours and hospitality suite, some meals, Friday-Sunday shagging, three workshops with multi-times National Shag Champions **Sam West and Sarah West Kemp**, and music by special guest **DJ Wilkie Whaley**, a regular from Fat Harolds.

CLASSIC FUND-RAISERS. Our fund-raisers will -- we hope -- give value and pleasure for your investment. On sale at the Classic: the beautiful **Don Borja-designed** Classic logo t-shirt, this time in black. On sale now at Nicks: raffle tickets for a chance to win admission to the Classic and a hotel room (see any Board member)...a private lesson with Sam and Sarah (**see Heather Jennings**)... a signed Becky Stowe print (**see Vesta Jones.**) Becky Stowe is the official artist of SOS. Previously we've raffled her music and dance-theme prints. This year's print depicts another part of our shag lifestyle -- the beach -- and it's lovely.

MORE TEAM SIGN-UP SHEETS. These team leaders will be signing up volunteers for the registration/Hospitality Desk (**Linda Silbaugh**); the floor crew (**Bonnie Mahoney**); decorations (**Pamela Alfano**). We'll set up late Thursday afternoon and that night at the Holiday Inn -- when we put down the floor, hang the signs, assemble the decorations, and laugh with and at each other.

It's fun, and we need you..

And **thank you** in advance for your contributions and attendance. You're good people, and a great bunch to work with, and I'm sure there's no reason to be crazy and nuts and deadline anxious... But if you want to get just a little bit that way and send in your stuff **RIGHT NOW!!!** that'll be okay, too.

BOARD HIGHLIGHTS



SUPPORTING HOSPICE/CLUB FINANCES: The Board has had conversations at the General Membership meeting, with some individual members, with some former Board members, and with leaders of other dance clubs regarding how to maintain our strong commitment to **Hospice**, finance this year's subsidy of the Classic, and also begin laying the financial base for some long-range "social" goals -- such as, more dances and/or renting a variety of facilities for our dances. Some of our members strongly support the existing fundraising scheme for Hospice (Shagathon, plus profits from all 50/50 raffles). Some of our members strongly recommend using Shagathon as our Hospice fund-raiser, and using our 50/50 raffles for club operations (which is the most common raffle policy of other dance clubs.) The Board decided on a **three-part policy**: (1) the club will continue giving Hospice the proceeds from 50/50 raffles at the major NVSC events (the Classic, workshop dances, the Christmas Party); (2) profits from the golf tournament will be shared with Hospice; (3) beginning in June, profits from the Wednesday night 50/50 raffles will go into the club's treasury. This decision was made somewhat easier by the realization that the **\$16,000**-plus donation to Hospice after February's Shagathon (which included some raffle proceeds) far exceeded our stated goal of \$10,000. In addition, other activities this year (proceeds from 50/50 raffles at major events and from the golf tournament) hopefully will allow us to give Hospice another generous gift at the Christmas Party.

MUSIC/SOCIAL: *Jerry Canada* will be the NVSC DJ at the joint dance w/hand dancers on **September 9th**.

DANCE: Discussions are underway with Charlie and Jackie regarding the January 2001 workshop/dance, so that the NVSC event will not conflict with Sam West's 2001 tribute to the late Shad Alberty. The workshop and dance will be either Jan. 6th or Jan. 13th, and --on either date -- likely will be held at Ft. Myer, where the club already holds a contracted date.

STORAGE: The Board invites membership ideas on this problem: Club decorations, SOS Parade props, signs, food service items etc.. are scattered in several locations (with Dave Shipp, Betty Abshire, Valerie Swiger, Donna Harrington, Vesta Jones, Kathryn Quattrone and First Spouse Dallas providing the bulk of this donated space). We're keeping this stuff because we've now got a big investment in these recyclables --- plus, we save a lot of time if event volunteers don't re-shop and re-build for every event. Our event crews would be greatly aided (and homeowners would get their closets and garages back) if these items were in a central location and accessible at any time. Suitable commercial storage would cost roughly **\$900** a year (the Board made about two dozen calls. It's cheaper "farther out," but that's a major logistics problem.) Should we rent space? Or, do you have major storage space to volunteer? One club member suggested that we build a storage shed, if someone had a centrally located backyard to volunteer. **Any other ideas?**...Basic requirements: Fairly large. Dry. (Climate controlled would be great, but we can't be greedy.) Lockable. Accessible to a few committee chairs, who'd have keys. Convenient to Springfield, Alexandria, Arlington, Fairfax areas where we have our main events.

TELEPHONE TREE: *Beverly Sgroi* has volunteered to organize a phone calling system to reach members who don't have e-mail, which is no longer a very long list. (**Thank you, Beverly.**) Beverly is looking for a few helpers to make a few calls -- only for major events, or if we've had to cancel events.
