President's Message

See you with your shag shoes on... at the fifth annual **Capital Shag Classic.**

Coming to You From Fat Harold's in North Myrtle Beach, SC

The Classic's guest DJ is **WILKIE WHALEY**, on staff at Fat Harold's Beach Club and Harold's at Ocean Drive. He's also played all the major clubs at North Myrtle Beach and many, many shag club parties in the Carolinas.

Wilkie's a native of Marion County, S.C. He got his introduction to R'n B at a tobacco barn. The farm workers listened to WYNN in Florence, which broadcast R'n B-- DJs "Satellite Papa" and "Moe the Rooster."

Wilkie graduated from Clemson in 1970. He began collecting music seriously in college, stocking his fraternity's jukebox with every record at the Pad. Wilkie's also a contributor to the organizations that help preserve our music and our dance. He's played SOS and DJ Throwdown, is currently the Vice President of the Association of Beach & Shag Club DJs, and has chaired the association's SOS float committee for four years, leading the DJs to one 1st place and three 2nd places in the parade.

WORLD-CLASS DANCERS...

The Classic's guest dance instructors are "**SAM-n-SARAH.**"... Shaggers say that like one word.
It means "champion."

They're **Sam West** and **Sarah West Kemp**, the brother and sister who, at one time or another, have won every division of every major national shag competition.

Initially, Sam and Sarah competed with other partners. For several consecutive years, either Sarah and her partner or Sam and his partner were the junior national shag champions, and each also won the non-pro shag championship. In the professional division, Sam and Sarah compete together. They've won **six** national championships in the pro division; **twice**, they were the overall national shag champions (meaning they beat all divisions of shaggers) at "the nationals" at the Beach; and **five times**, they won the shag championship at the Grand Nationals in Atlanta.

Sam and Sarah also have taken our dance to a national audience. They're 8-year members of the traveling National Shag Dance Team, and they've won the shag division of the U.S. Open swing championships in Los Angeles and the American Swing Dance championships in New York.

WILKIE will play for us on Friday and Saturday nights. **SAM & SARAH** will teach three Saturday workshops and will join us on the dance floor.

Board Highlights

Following are highlights from the June Board meeting and from the General Membership meeting on Sunday, June 21.

MUSIC/DJs: The Wednesday-night "regular rotation" of NVSC DJs has been expanded to include Gerry Scott. The Board also created opportunities for several guest DJ opportunities on Wednesday nights. Jerry Canada will play a Wednesday guest slot in July. (Jerry also will play with Eddie & Denny at the joint hand dancer/NVSC party in September.) With the occasional Wednesday night guest DJs, the joint parties with hand dance/NVSC DJs, and our hires of out-of-town DJs for several Saturday dances, the NVSC will have heard 8 or 9 guest DJs by the end of 2000. In finalizing the 2000 DJ calendar, the Board tried to provide equal treatment of several different members, and groups of members, who've asked to hear specific DJs; provide some stability for, and special consideration of, our loyal "regular rotation" DJs who've made the NVSC their central focus; and also recognize and show appreciation for the several other NVSC-member DJs, who're more closely affiliated with other clubs but who've also made significant contributions to, and friendships with, the NVSC.

SUNDAY SOCIAL -- Adjustments to the Wednesday DJ rotation may mean some changes in the Sunday Social DJing, which has been handled by Gerry Scott alone. Club members discussed the pros and cons of continuing monthly Sunday Socials, which have a turnout of some 20 to 30 people - sometimes fewer in the summer months. One proposal: quarterly Sunday Socials. That, and other options, will be studied.

CLUB FINANCING/CAPITAL SHAG CLASSIC -- General discussion of workshop income and costs; Saturday parties income and costs; Sunday Social costs; and the requirement to subsidize the Classic since its move to the more expensive hotel. After studying results of the upcoming Classic, Board will share the information with the club and will solicit a general discussion of the financing and format of future Classics.

TAX STATUS --The club has a non-profit social club status, which means we do not pay taxes on income received. This is not the same as a charitable organization, and therefore people can not deduct money that they contribute to the NVSC. The IRS, the Postal Service, and several private accountants have advised the Board that, while the NVSC supports a charity (Hospice), the club itself has a social purpose and does not qualify for the "charitable" status. However, members raised the possibility of exploring that subject again, and possibly creating a spin-off organization, or other legal structure, that would qualify as a tax-exempt charity. The Treasurer and the Newsletter Editor have spent many hours on this subject, and the Board welcomes any volunteer who might see a new (and legal!) tax angle and who'd be willing to take on this horrendous research chore.
