September is a stellar month for shaggers. One of the magic months, when thousands of us go "home" to the beach for SOS. It's tradition. It's ritual. It's compelling. IT IS FUN! Not even hurricanes and washed-out highways that doubled our travel time have ever kept us away. But first, at home base in Northern Virginia, we'll start the magic on **Sept. 9th** with a **pre-SOS party**.

Special this year:

It's a joint party with our hand dance friends, allowing us to return the hospitality of the DC MD VA Hand Dance Association, which hosted a terrific joint party in March. Early in the evening (7:30 PM) hand dance lesson by **Eddie O'Reilly**. He's a special friend -- an officer of the hand dance club, but also an NVSC regular on Wednesday night at Nicks and a major workhorse on the floor crew for our Classic. DJ's **Jerry Canada** and **Eddy Farmer & Denny Martin**. All of them were active and provided many services in the earliest days of the NVSC and have retained their ties to our club. So, while they're sort of "guest" DJs, they're also coming home.

Then on to the beach! Here's the newest thing on the NVSC calendar for SOS:

Limited free-pour parties, co-hosted by the NVSC, Ducks and Blvd. Grill. "**Limited**" means that our club and these two bars have contributed a certain amount to the bar tab, and any NVSC member can drink free soft drinks and other beverages ("shooters" at Ducks, bar drinks at Blvd.. Grill) until the tab runs out.

The party at **Ducks** is **First Saturday of SOS**, starting at **4 PM**.

The party at **Blvd.. Grill** is **Second Saturday of SOS**, starting at **4 PM**.

"Until the tab runs out" suggests that "starting time" might be the best time to show up!

While you're at SOS, if you can, Please drop by **Fat Harolds**, and the new **Harolds on the Beach**, and thank them for sponsoring a hospitality suite at the Classic. And look for "play times" by Fat Harolds' DJ, Wilkie Whaley, who DJ'd our Classic. Please thank **Norfleet** and **Cooter at Ducks** for sponsoring a hospitality suite at our Classic. Please thank Ducks and Blvd Grill for hiring NVSC-- DJ's. SOS play times for **Craig Jennings** and **Larry Jones** are inside the newsletter. Please shop at the Company Store between 3 to 5 PM on the last Friday of SOS, when the NVSC has its sales hours. Please check your for ads that give the workshop times for **Ellen Taylor** and for **Charlie & Jackie**. They're so much more than shag icons. They're friends, who've advised the NVSC dance program and always given much more than they've been paid for. The SOS "thank you" list is lengthy, isn't it? It means, I think, that our club has become a fixture at the beach, contributing to the shag community and being welcomed into it. Good work, all. You deserve the recognition, as a club and as dancers. Joan.

Board Highlights

Most business of the August Board meeting is covered in the President's letter and in articles and flyers elsewhere in the newsletter on SOS, our videotape lending program, and upcoming events. These are additional highlights from that meeting.

CAPITAL SHAG CLASSIC 2000: The "subsidy beast" has been tamed. With the move to the new hotel and a policy of keeping a low ticket price, The Classic subsidy was some \$2000 in 1999. This year, the subsidy was eliminated IF you take into account the aggressive outside fundraising that was pledged to the weekend party (raffling free lessons with Charlie & Jackie, diverting some Wednesday night 50/50 raffle profits to the Classic, etc.) Even if the outside fund-raisers are not counted, The Classic's subsidy still was cut about in half - through a combination of budget cuts, weekend raffles, donations by members, and sponsorship and advertiser money. The new golf tournament made roughly \$900 in profits - again, primarily in sponsorship money. Per our agreement with sponsors, half the tournament profits will go to Hospice of Northern Virginia. Half the tournament profits were applied to costs of The Classic.

CLASSIC 2001: will be the last weekend in July, the 27th to 29th. This avoids conflict with Junior SOS, which is the third weekend in July. Per many requests, talks are underway to determine if the hotel can sell an optional late-night meal, or heavy snacks, to Classic guests who wish to purchase that. For 2001, the hotel will not increase our costs for ballroom setup and use, or for the use of a lobby-area dance instruction room. It again will provide a certain number of reduced-rate and free rooms (available for the hospitality suite, the guest instructors, etc.), if we reach our room-booking quota. However, dinner-breakfast costs will increase by about 4 percent. (Full breakfast, not continental, provided both days.) The hotel also will increase the room rate for Classic attendees by \$5. The rate will be \$84 per room, with four people per room allowed.

T-SHIRT NIGHT at Nicks on Wednesday, Oct 11th. Members encouraged to wear any club-logo or Capital Shag Classic shirt.
