Directions to the Virginia Ballroom

From the Capital Beltway (I-495): Take Arlington Boulevard (Rt 50) West towards Fairfax. Turn right at the third light onto Prosperity Avenue. Turn left at the first light, which is Lee Highway (Rt 29), Virginia Ballroom will be the second building immediately on your right. Enter from the front or the back entrance.

From I-66: Take the Nutley Street exit towards Rt. 29 (Do not head towards Vienna). At the 3rd light, take a left onto Lee Highway (29). Go through the next 2 lights. Virginia Ballroom is approximately one mile further on your left. If you pass the intersection of Prosperity and 29 you have gone too far.

Recipe of the Month

Sweet Potato Casserole (Christmas party --so good)

2 15oz cans sweet potatoes (not in syrup)
2 Cups sugar
4 Eggs
3 tsp. vanilla
1 cup melted butter
2/3 cup milk

Beat all of the above together, pour into 13 x 9 casserole dish,

Topping:

1 cup dark brown sugar
1 cup chopped nuts (pecans work well)
1/3 cup flour
1/3 cup melted butter

Mix together, crumble over the top of casserole, bake 350 degrees for 40 minutes.

This is the large version of this recipe, if you have a small group, cut the filling part of the recipe in half, but make the topping with the same quantities.

Shag A Thon Peanut Butter Dip

1/4 cup peanut butter (low fat)
2 tablespoons thawed orange juice concentrate
1/8 teaspoon cinnamon

Mix well, garnish with cinnamon sticks, mandarin orange sections or sliced oranges.

Serve with carrots, sliced apples, crackers, mini rice cakes, whatever strikes your fancy.

If you have any left over, spread on toast for high energy breakfast.

Info on Junior Shaggers...

As many of you know, NVSC now has several junior shaggers (those under 21) as members of our club. These include **Kari and Kristin Jones, Ben and Tory Robinette, Justin Testa, Amanda Tedesco and Brennar Goree**. We are thrilled to have these kids as members since one of the primary goals of this club is to promote and preserve the shag. Juniors are the future of our dance and as such, we want to support them in any way possible. To that end, the NVSC Board voted in January to establish a junior shaggers account. To finance this account, the proceeds from the first 50/50 of each month will be deposited into the account. Any private donations received from NVSC members (we've already received one very generous anonymous donation!) will also be placed into this account. The kids may then request funds from the account in order to further their dancing. For example, the kids may request funds for: membership to junior SOS, junior contest entry fees, and lessons and coaching for juniors. Each request will be considered by the Board and granted based on the practicality of the request (no, we can't afford to send y'all to Hawaii!) and the balance in the account. We hope that in this way, we can continue to support our juniors and by doing so, this dance we all love. We will, of course, also continue with the NVSC policy of allowing juniors to attend ALL NVSC events (with an adult) for FREE (with the sole exception being the Capital Shag Classic), and continue to support the juniors through our corporate membership of the Junior Shag Association. So remember folks – if you have kids, grandkids, nieces, nephews, friends or family that are under 21, **BRING THEM TO DANCE!** They are more than welcome at any of our events and it is FREE for them. Also – if you are interested in donating to the juniors, see Dennis Gehley, our Treasurer, or buy extra 50/50's the first Wednesday of each month.
