I'm here to tell you about an opportunity that most of you missed. It's a shame really, a cryin' shame. On the night of June 15 in a small club in Springfield, VA, an intimate crowd was thrilled and entertained by the good ole boys of the **Coastline Band**. It was an awesome show! Now, I will admit that **JAXX** is a scary, SCARY place, and not what most of us are accustomed to when seeking live entertainment. However, I will tell you that the boys rocked the place to the ground! And as these 5 young men filled the club with music, no longer did you see the black walls

painted with the names of past performers. No longer did you see the faded carpet in the lobby or the old booths down in front. What I saw was the stage alive with action and music! What I saw was the dance floor full of shaggers! What I saw was people drinkin' beer and having a good old time! It was like being at the beach right here in Northern Virginia! A treat that rarely comes around this far North!

Now, these boys from the Coastline Band are an award winning band. They have won many CAMMY awards for Song of the Year, and Entertainers of the Year. See them live, and you will never doubt it! I had the pleasure of experiencing them at the Beach Music Festival in Virginia Beach in May. They are phenomenal! The only member of the band that doesn't rotate through all of the instruments on stage is the drummer. He stays put. These guys have an incredible talent. At one point in the show, the lead singer, Jim Quick, was playing the keyboard with a valve trombone in his hand, all the while singing his guts out!

They played 320 one-nighters through NC and SC last year. I was disappointed that as large and active as our shag club is, we couldn't muster more than a handful of noisemakers! Fellow noisemakers included Gary and Sharon Salpini, Dave and Ruth Rapson, Dave Shipp, H.K. Lee, Pauline Easby-Smith, and Chris & Jacki Robinette. We were also joined by a few of the Lynchburg shaggers, including Brenda Franklin, and her brother, Glen. All these rowdy folks helped me celebrate my birthday! In Gary's words, "we all had an extremely large time!" Even the members of the band joined in the celebration, and managed to embarrass me quite painfully! I got to shag with Jim Quick! He then taught me how to clog. Now that's a moment I won't soon forget!!

It would be a cryin' shame if these boys didn't come back. They are scheduled to return in February. I am hoping that we can fill the club to standing room only for that show! The cover charge was \$12.00, and the band played 2 sets. We shagged well into the night, and into the next morning! If you've never had the chance to witness this musical extravaganza first hand, mark your calendars for February. Let's show them that they are not wasting their time in coming to play for us. Not only that, come join us in a night of music and dancing and FUN! I'd hate for y'all to miss out AGAIN!

Listen everyone. If this is going to work (beach music at Jaxx) we (that's our club) are going to have to promo it to get some attendance or Jay (the owner of JAXX) is going to give it up: \$\$\$ It's that simple. Chocolate Caramel Bars *by Reta Ferguson*

Base:

1 pkg. Pillsbury German Chocolate Cake Mix
1/3 cup margarine or butter, softened
1 egg

Topping:

1 cup (6 oz.) semi-sweet chocolate chips
1/2 cup chopped nuts
3/4 cup caramel ice cream topping
3 tablespoons flour

Louise's Peas - Janet Egan's reci"pea"

1 lb. frozen peas - microwave about 3 minutes; drain & cool
3-4 chopped green onions
1 can Hickory Smoked Almonds (Smokehouse, blue diamond)
1/2 cup mayonnaise
curry powder to taste
Mix ingredients together. Serve chilled.
Enjoy!

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour 13x9-inch pan. In large bowl combine cake mix, margarine and egg at low speed until crumbly. Reserve 1 cup crumbs for topping. Press remaining crumb mixture in greased and floured pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 8-10 minutes or until base is slightly puffy. Sprinkle with chocolate chips and nuts. In small bowl combine caramel topping and flour; blend well. Pour over chocolate chips and nuts; sprinkle with reserved crumbs. Bake at 350 degrees for 10-20 minutes or until chocolate chips are melted and caramel topping begins to bubble. Cool completely; cut into 36 bars.
