Well... the summer may be coming to a close, but that just means its time for NVSC to heat things up! We still have lots of HOT activities planned for the remainder of the year! First and foremost we have a **PRE-SOS dance** and party scheduled for **September 8th at Ft. Myer** in Arlington. There will be BOTH a beginner and an advanced lesson from 7-8pm that night with dancing from 8-midnight. If you've got some friends who are interested in learning, but are usually too timid to attend a regular dance, this is the perfect opportunity. They can take the beginner class first and then dance and socialize in a wonderful, relaxed setting while you prepare your feet for SOS! See the flyer inside for details.

And speaking of SOS... "Fall Migration" will be here before you know it! The dates are **Sept. 14-23** this year. For those making the trip down to North Myrtle Beach, NVSC is again sponsoring **two FREE pours**. The first is **Sept. 15, 4-6 pm** at Ducks. The second is **Sept. 22th, 4-6pm** at Boulevard Grill. Looking a little farther ahead, we have another GREAT shag workshop and dance planned for **October 13**. This year our fall workshop instructors will be **Mike & Kay Anderson** from Cary, NC! Many of our members may remember Mike & Kay from the smoothies contest at SOS or perhaps from meeting them last month at the Classic. **Mike & Kay** are **PRO** level dancers who have competed at the National Shag Dance Championships for many years. We are thrilled to have them as our guest instructors!

That night, as always, we will also have a **dance**. The dance will be held at the **beautiful Kenwood Country Club** in Bethesda, MD! We have had dances there in the past, but not recently so it should be exciting going to a "new" place! There will be heavy hors d' oeuvres provided that night and a cash bar. Be on the lookout for more details soon!

On a different subject, I need to mention a few changes that will be occurring at Nick's beginning this month. Starting **Sept. 12** the cover at Nick's will go from \$3 to \$4 for our regular Wednesday night meetings. This was done per Nick's request to help him cover some additional costs. Also - Nick suggested that his staff could provide better wait and kitchen service to us if we stagger our shag **class times**, so that they don't all end at the same time. In order to accommodate this request, we are planning to implement the following schedule **as of Sept. 12**, which is week ONE of the lesson cycle.

1) Advanced: 7:15 - 8:00 2) Intro/Beginner: 7:30 - 8:15 3) Intermediate: 7:45 - 8:30

Take I-395 to exit 8A Washington Blvd, Route 27 North. Take Washington Blvd North to Fort Myer exit on right. Go thru gate and turn left at 1st stop sign onto McNair. Community Center is several buildings down on your LEFT. Parking lot on the right.

From West Northern Virginia:

From the Beltway, take Rt. 50 East toward Arlington to the Washington Blvd/Pentagon exit. Go south to FIRST exit on right (Courthouse Rd/Ft Myer Exit). Turn LEFT on Courthouse Rd, then Left on 2nd street to Ft Myer. Go thru gate and turn left at 1st stop sign onto McNair. Community Center is several buildings down on your LEFT. Parking lot on the right.

NEW LESSON TIMES for SHAG CLASSES at Nick's

It has come to our attention that having all three of our dance classes end at the same time (8:15 PM), means that Nick's wait staff, bartenders and kitchen staff get a large number of nearly simultaneous orders for food and drink when the classes end. Nick and Duncan (the manager) have suggested that their staff could provide better service to NVSC if we stagger the class times, so that they don't all end at the same time. Nick has said that he is also planning to put a second waitress to work on Wednesday evening.

In order to accommodate the request to stagger class-ending times, the following schedule will be implemented as of **September 12**, the first week of the next four week lesson cycle.

- 1) **Advanced:** 7:15 - 8:00
- 2) **Intro/Beginner:** 7:30 - 8:15
- 3) **Intermediate:** 7:45 - 8:30

General dancing will still take place on the main floor from 8:15 - 11:00 pm.

AS OF SEPTEMBER 12, the cover charge at Nick's for Wednesday nights will increase from \$3 to \$4.
