NEW LESSON TIMES for SHAG CLASSES at Nick's

It has come to our attention that having all three of our dance classes end at the same time (8:15 PM), means that Nick's wait staff, bartenders and kitchen staff get a large number of nearly simultaneous orders for food and drink when the classes end. 

