4th Annual NVSC Shag-a-thon:

On February 9th, 2002 at Landmark Mall, Duke Street, Alexandria, Virginia, the Northern Virginia Shag Club will sponsor the fourth annual Shag-a-thon! The primary purpose of this event is to raise money for the club's charity, **Hospice of Northern Virginia**. In addition, we will be able to promote the dance we love and hopefully attract new dancers to our group. Anyone who has participated will tell you what a fun event this is to be involved in. You will want to make your plans to participate. Unfortunately all of us will be touched at some point in our lives by the work that Hospice does in assisting families of terminally ill patients. What a worthwhile organization to come out and dance your feet off for!

To participate in the event you first need to **sign-up**. Sign up packets are available at the club on Wednesday nights and at other Shag events. Next you need to take your pledge sheet to as many friends, family and co-workers as possible and ask them to "sponsor" you for this event. By sponsoring you, they agree to pay a certain amount for each dance you have during the event or they may choose to make a flat donation. This is not an endurance event - you may dance as many or as few dances as you like. Each sponsor needs to fill out a pledge sheet with their name, address and pledge amount. It is as simple as that! Please try and get as many pledges as possible!

On the day of the event, February 9th, bring only your "Flat Pledge Contribution Sheets" and checks to the Shag-a-thon for turn-in and dance, dance, dance!! Do not bring your "Per Dance Pledge Contribution Sheet" to the Shag-a-thon. Please bring your "Per Dance Pledge Contribution Sheet" to the Shag Club any Wednesday after the Shag-a-thon for collection. Turn these sheets/monies in to either Rob Creedon or Cathy Metcalf. All pledge money must be turned in by Wednesday, March 6, 2002.

This event raised **\$20,000** for **Hospice of Northern Virginia** last year and we hope to raise even more this year. If you can't dance that day, consider sponsoring one of the other dancers, volunteering at a registration or information table, volunteering to make a snack, or just come by and cheer us on.

Volunteers are needed for helping out on the day of the event at the check in table for participants, the information table, and for bringing snacks for the dancers. Please send Rob an e-mail if you would like to volunteer to assist. Thanks to all who support this event by dancing, obtaining pledges, making pledges, set up, playing music, lending sound equipment, volunteering at the tables, organizing, and clean up.

2002 SHAG-A-THON INFORMATION SHEET

Thank you for agreeing to participate in the Northern Virginia Shag Club's fourth annual Shag-a-thon! We hope you will thoroughly enjoy this event! While the primary purpose of the Shag-a-thon is to raise money for the club's charity, Hospice of Northern Virginia, we also hope to attract new members to the shag club. With your support, we hope to make this a very successful annual fundraising event for the club. Last year was a big success: we raised \$20,000 through the Shag-a-thon. Our goal for this year is \$22,000!

1. **Date and Time:** Saturday, February 9, 2002, 12 Noon to 5:00 pm
2. **Location:** Landmark Mall, Alexandria, VA - Center Court
3. **Pledge Sheet:** Ask as many friends, family and coworkers as possible to sponsor you for this event. Have them fill out the pledge sheet with their name, address, phone number and pledge amount.
4. **Pledge Amounts:** Pledge amounts are up to each sponsor by choosing a flat donation or a "per-dance" donation (i.e. \$0.50 or \$1.00 per dance). For the "per-dance" option, you may want to give the sponsor an idea of how many dances you plan to dance - i.e., 4 dances an hour at 50 cents a dance would be \$10, if you dance for the entire event. Please note there are two pledge sheets in each packet. Enter the amount per-dance from those sponsors on the "Per Dance Pledge Contribution Sheet." Enter flat pledge contribution amounts on the "Flat Pledge Contribution Sheet." In order to reach the Shag-a-thon goal, each participant is asked to strive for \$100 - \$200 in total pledges. Participants who obtain less than \$25 in pledges are asked to pay a \$10 participation fee.
5. **Amount Paid/Balance:** If your sponsor elects a flat pledge contribution, ask if they would like to pay in advance. If so, note the amount paid and a zero balance in the appropriate columns of your pledge sheet. **Have all checks made out to: "Hospice of Northern Virginia."** The donation may be tax deductible.
6. **Collecting pledges:** Bring only your "Flat Pledge Contribution Sheet" and those contributions to the Shag-a-thon for turn in. The first Wednesday after the event, your pledge sheet will be returned to you with the "Balance" calculated for each sponsor. Please return to each sponsor and collect any uncollected pledges.
7. **Collecting pledges:** Bring your "Per Dance Pledge Contribution Sheet" to the Shag Club any Wednesday after the Shag-a-thon for collection. Turn these sheets/monies in to either Rob Creedon or Cathy Metcalf. All outstanding pledge money must be turned in by Wednesday, March 6, 2002.
8. **Corporate sponsors:** Consider asking employers or others to be a Corporate Sponsor. Sponsors who donate \$50 or more will be considered Corporate Sponsors. All Corporate Sponsors will be recognized during the event.
