“Why should I take a private shag lesson?” *By Heather Jennings*

I am asked this question often by members of NVSC. “After all,” most of them reason, “I’m not a competitive shag dancer. Why would I need a private lesson?” Well... it turns out, the reasons are actually numerous. If you have ever thought to yourself during a group lesson, “geesh I wish they’d slow down” or “I really want to ask a question about that, but I’m too shy!” or the ever popular “darn, I was talking/eating/drinking/sleeping when they went over the step and now I’ve missed it. I wish they’d do it again!” then you have some excellent reasons to consider private lessons. Private shag lessons provide a one-on-one teaching experience that cannot be gained through group lessons or via video tapes. In a private lesson, you can proceed as fast or as slow as you like and ask as many or as few questions as you want.

“But our guest instructors are soooo goood!” I’ve heard. “What will I gain from a private lesson with them?” Well... while some of our guest instructors may be good enough to have you believe they were born shagging, I honestly don’t believe that any of them truly were. Which means, of course, that they all started out in the same place as the rest of us: 1) in a beginner shag class, 2) learning shag from a friend, or 3) picking it up at a beach music festival while balancing a beer in one hand and their partner with the other! In other words, they started at the beginning, have gotten to where they are over time, and have a wealth of information to share. During a private lesson you can ask for tips on shag technique, new mirror steps, or whatever you like. When you take a private lesson, you’ve HIRED your instructor so you’re in charge!

“But I’ve taken all of the classes at NVSC...isn’t that enough?” Absolutely. Our dance committee teaches a great program of shag fundamentals and more advanced steps. However if you’ve ever caught yourself thinking, “geesh I’m bored with these steps” or “why can’t they teach different steps in the intermediate classes?” then you may want to consider a private lesson. As a shag club we can only offer so much in our structured classes. For those who have reached a plateau with their dancing or simply want “more, more, more”, private lessons can be the answer!

“Okay,” you might be saying... “you’ve convinced me. I want to take a private lesson! How do I do it?” Well...luckily, this April, we have another pair of excellent shag teachers, **Bill & Brenda Barber**, coming for a workshop and they will be offering private shag lessons while they are here. So how do you get a private lesson with them? Well, it’s simple! All you have to do is sign-up! Call me at home at 540-775-5342 or e-mail me at hjennings@sental.com and I’ll put you on schedule. I can’t promise that you’ll be dancing like Bill & Brenda following your lesson, but after a few beers at the next beach music festival, you’ll definitely have fun trying! And that’s what shag is all about: fun!
