from Larry Boyer, Communications Chairman:

1) I have created a **mail box** on my phone answering service for use as the NVShag Club "Hotline". By dialing **703-960-4254** and selecting the **Hotline mail box** you can hear information about coming attractions - like the next Beginning and Intermediate lessons, the next major shag club sponsored event, or possibly, last minute picnic cancellations due to weather. Any messages left in the hotline mail box will not be heard. If you want to leave a message for the club, there is a mail box for that purpose at the same number. Messages left in the shag club mail box will receive attention, but do not expect a rapid response. For example, if you leave a message like: "I want to go to KC's this evening, can you give me directions"; don't count on getting a reply by the time you need it.

2) Many of you already know that we have acquired an **auto-dialer phone tree** system to help keep you better informed about important coming events. It automatically dials a list of numbers and delivers a recorded message to whoever answers, person or machine. It has been used already on several occasions and was very helpful in getting the word out about the 11th hour cancellation of the Baby Boomers event. Included in the calling list are all member phone numbers with 703, 202, 301, 240 or 571 area codes that can be dialed from my house in Alexandria without needing a 1 prefix. If you are outside this calling area and still want to be informed about the phone tree messages, then you may want to make an arrangement with a friend in the calling area willing to pass along to you important messages. During the message, you can make it repeat by pressing your "star" key. We anticipate using the system only for important announcements and reminders, like 2 or 3 times per month, and the messages will be delivered mostly during the day and never before 10 AM or after 9 PM. If you find these messages annoying, don't be annoyed, just let me know you would like to be removed from the list. A message in the shag club mail box would be the surest way to get it done.

Shag Contest at the Beach Music Festival -May 16th -19th

The **Beach Music Festival** is an annual festival held at the Virginia Beach oceanfront. The **shag contest** will be held on two evenings (Friday, May 17th and Saturday, May 18th), and will include FIVE DIVISIONS (Junior I, Junior II, Amateur, Non-Pro, and Pro).
