RUNWAY BOOGIE IN BECKLEY AND

Several members of NVSC made the scenic drive to Beckley, West Virginia in August to attend the **Runway Boogie** weekend party put on by the Beckley Shag Club and Jim Hern. This annual event is held at the CPO Club on Little Creek Naval Amphibious Base, the East Coast home of the U.S. Navy Seals.

Many club members and friends were present, including Chris and Hugh Tant, all the way in from Charleston, SC. ABSC deejays Larry Jones and Craig Jennings played on Friday night, with Clyde Waller and Butch Metcalf providing the music on Saturday. Emcee Steve Booth announced the awards for the seventh year, adding class and dignity to this joyful event.

Breathtaking shag demonstrations were performed by none other than some of our own junior shaggers, Amanda Tedesco, dancing with Junior National Champion Grant Garmon, and national competitors Adam Sheppard and Kari Jones. Many eyes welled with tears, as these superb young dancers filled the room with the magic of stylish elegance and grace. Lawrence Bradford and BJ Jones provided the grand finale in the exhibition dancing with a dazzling piece of choreography which was the crown jewel of the evening. Living Legend (and NVSC member) Susie Beaver and her partner, new inductee Calvin Wade, had to be some of the proudest and happiest people in the room, having shared the joy of shag dance with so many.

The National Living Legends of Dance was founded in Virginia Beach in 1994 for the purpose of giving recognition to all styles of dance across the United States. Inductees have been proposed and voted on by an Advisory Board that has given consideration to their contribution and influence in their particular dance styles.

At the same event, NVSC Junior Grant Garmon of Virginia Beach received the 2002 National Living Legends Scholarship.
