The 2004 NVSC Shag-a-Thon in support of our charity, Hospice of Northern Virginia, was held on March 27, 2004 at Springfield Mall. NVSC adopted Hospice as its charity in 1997, and held the first annual Shag-a-Thon to raise money to help support the organization in 1999. The Shag-a-Thon has been an extremely successful and effective means of raising money to support the operations of Hospice, and this year was no exception. The 2004 Shag-a-Thon figure includes \$7,273.00, which was raised by our fundraising partner, the law firm of Reed Smith, the assistance of which is gratefully acknowledged.

Since 1998, total fundraising proceeds for Hospice through the efforts of NVSC members have topped \$100,000.00. Further review of older financial records may reveal additional donations.

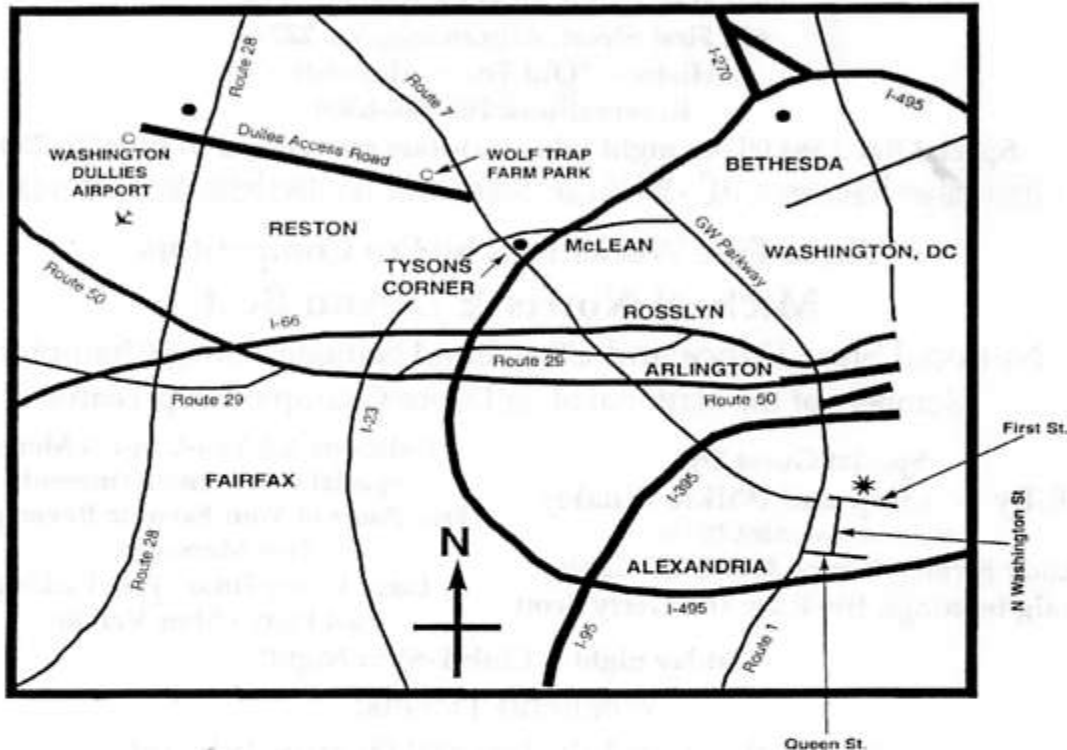
