As most of you know, NVSC is planning one of it's special shag workshop & dance events for Saturday, November 6th and as always we have asked some amazing dance instructors to be our guests. However, some of our newer members may be wondering just "Who are Sam & Lisa West?"

For those who may not know, Sam West is an eleven-time shag divisional winner at the National Shag Dance Championships with five Overall Titles. He has also won six times at the Grand Nationals, twice at the US Open and placed or won at many other dance competitions including Swing Fling, the American Swing Dance Championships and numerous Competitive Shaggers Association contests. He is also a past member of the National Shag Dance Team and the only person to have competed every year since it's inception (1984) at the National Shag Dance Championships.

Lisa West is an accomplished country and swing dancer and with her partner Barry Durand has won the American Swing Dance Championships several times and US Open Cabaret among other national events. Lisa has also competed and placed in the Non-Pro division at the National Shag Dance Championships.

With all these accomplishments (and more!), you can see why NVSC is honored and thrilled to have these nationally acclaimed and immensely talented performers and instructors visit our shag club. Don't miss the opportunity to learn from these amazing folks!!! *The workshops and dance are planned for November 6th - put this date on your calendar NOW!!!!*

Note: Sam is the current National Shag Dance Champion. He has been the champion in the Pro division every year (except for one) since 1995 for a total of 9 times (tying Charlie Womble) NVSC is very lucky to be able to have Sam & Lisa come and teach for us!!!
