Appreciation: A special thanks to one of our long-time NVSC members, **Craig Hutchinson**, Feather Award nominee and member of the National Living Legends of Dance. Many of you know him as "Hutch," the local guru of the several forms of swing dance (shag is a Southern style of swing). But many of you may not know the extent of his contributions to the dance community, and specifically to Carolina Shag. He was responsible for bringing shag to the attention of the national competitive dance community. *According to the book SHAG, published in 1995, he was the first to bring shag out of the Southeast. Back in the 1980's, Craig saw Charlie Womble and Jackie McGee dance in Myrtle Beach and invited them to a national swing dance competition in Oklahoma ... that event opened the door for shag to become known competitively coast-to-coast. He opened the door for shag expansion to its highest potential.* (Excerpt from NVSC's shag history.) The national recognition created interest and growth in shag, bringing young dancers out of the South (who took the dance community by surprise) and who will be the ones to carry shag forward. Thus, Craig's contribution to shag is lasting and ongoing. These days Craig is coping with health issues, but he is still quietly supporting NVSC, behind the scenes. The Saturday Shag Dances held at the PSDC dance room in Vienna are an example of his generosity and support. This newly renovated "in place" to dance is open to the public -- thereby bringing potential new members to the club. Craig shares the cover charge with us, the amount depending on attendance. This year, the Saturday Shag Dances are being sponsored by NVSC... Did you know that 100% of the club's proceeds from these Saturday dances goes into our junior fund? And, by supporting junior shaggers, we help to perpetuate the shag dance, and also help our club to grow, through the extended family that juniors bring with them. **A BIG "Thank you, Craig!"**

Purpose: From the NVSC by-laws -- the purpose of our club is to promote Carolina Shag dancing in Northern Virginia and other areas; and to provide its members with dance venues and opportunities to associate with others who enjoy Carolina Shag dancing.

**CAROLINA SHAG STEPS ON NVSC LIBRARY VIDEOS**

**Mirror Patterns / Male Lead - Tape 1 - Charlie Womble & Jackie McGee**

Pause Walk-Up	Pause Walk-Up with Boogie Walk
Arch	Arch with Male Turn
Side Step	Backwalk into Pivot
Tuck	Side Spread
Barrel	Side Spread with Backwalk Away
Ducks	Arm Up Pivot

Shag Dance Technique - as taught by Ellen Taylor

Review of Basics (with technique)	Side Pass/Male Lead into Pivot
Shag Start	Female Underarm Turn/Toe Point and Turn (mirror pattern)
Female Underarm Turn	Side Jump with Hesitation (mirror pattern)
Male Underarm Turn	Craig's Boogie Turn
Pivot	Ellen Taylor Wraparound Pivot

- July 27th Double Kick Basic, Front Prep & Lean

HEY, MR. DJ...

I was making a visit to another Shag Club, a regular stop of mine in my travels, and it's surprising what you hear. I was standing in the back solving the shag world's problems over a cold beverage with some club members, when I heard one of them say... "the music tonight is terrible, old "Joe Bob" just doesn't play anything good." Then, he turns to me and says..."Jim, you're a DJ, isn't this music really bad?"

Well, I looked around and noticed the dance floor was full and the people dancing seemed happy and had continued to dance to every song. I had even been talking with "Joe Bob" and more than one person came up and told him they liked the music and thought he was doing a great job! Wow, so now how do you answer a loaded question like that?

Well, at some point in time, you just have to light the fuse and let it rip! So I told them that the music is in the ear of the listener. What "Joe Bob" was playing wasn't my favorite, but I certainly danced to it! And, there were many people on the floor dancing and enjoying the music. "Joe Bob" was trying to please as many people in a short period as he could. He played a varied selection and kept people on the dance floor...just what he is supposed to do!

It's virtually impossible to please everyone musically on any given night. Let's take a look at it this way. We at NVSC start about 8:30 PM and play until 11:00 PM. With most people leaving by 10:30, we play for only two hours. With most songs averaging 3 minutes, that's approximately 40 songs being played.

If a DJ plays only 10 of the Top 40 songs, 5 newer songs, and takes **only** 5 requests, that leaves 20 songs to play for the rest of the evening. With over 10,000 songs to choose from, it's a very tough job choosing 20 songs that will please everyone! Don't you agree?

So, the next time you find yourself complaining about the music you're hearing, see if you can quickly think of 20 songs you'd play to make 40-50 people happy! But most importantly, when you don't like what's being played...come up to the DJ booth and request some music you like!

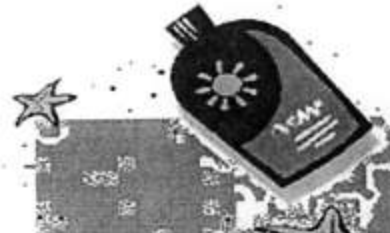

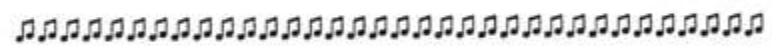
