The Richmond Shag Club will be giving free shag lessons from 3-4 p.m.

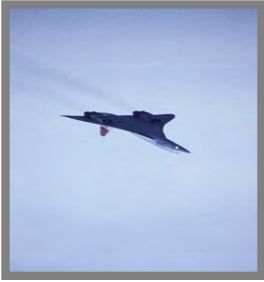
Tickets are \$15 each before May 15; \$25 each after May 15.

CCU BEACH MUSIC HALL OF FAME

In May 2009 the South Carolina General Assembly passed a resolution naming Coastal Carolina University the official home of the Beach Music Hall of Fame. Recognizing that Beach Music is an important part of the history and culture of the Grand Strand and South Carolina, it is most fitting that the home will be in an educational venue. This in no way "competes" with the Cammy's (Carolina Beach Music Association).

This first class of inductees will honor songs and artists whose work debuted prior to 1955. The ten songs to be enshrined are "Sixty Minute Man" (Dominoes), "Shake, Rattle and Roll" (Big Joe Turner), "Ain't That a Shame" (Fats Domino), "The Great Pretender" (The Platters), "Green Eyes" (The Ravens), "Mama He Treats Your Daughter Mean" (Ruth Brown), "Nip Sip" (The Clovers), "One Mint Julep" (The Clovers), "White Christmas" (The Drifters), and "Drinkin' Wine Spo-Dee-O-Dee" (Sticks McGhee).

The eight artists to be inducted are Hank Ballard, Ruth Brown, The Clovers, Fats Domino, The Drifters, Louie Jordan, Amos Milburn and Big Joe Turner.

The late greats General Norman Johnson and Solomon Burke will also be honored at the ceremony.

Advisory board members include Steve Bailey, Jason Cagle, Hilda Carter, Charles Dalton, Cliff Ellis, Selene Graham, Pat Howle, Kay Maddox, Eddie Ray, Dan O'Reilly, Rose Rock, Billy Scott, Don Sloan, Bubber Snow, Charles Stafford, Barry Thigpen, Dino Thompson, Jack Thompson, Harry Turner and Bob Wood.

Dino Thompson, chairman of the Beach Music Hall of Fame advisory board, said these artists are the pioneers of what we consider Beach Music today. He added that this is a way to honor them so they will not be the "forgotten giants" and that the new recording and performing artists "stand on the shoulders" of these legendary greats.

Rose Rock recalled the power of these musical heroes to tear down racial barriers. In the 1950's at the famous Paramount Theatre in Brooklyn, there were actual ropes to separate black and white kids who attended concerts there. Once the music started, the ropes came down and everyone enjoyed the experience together.

This inaugural Induction Ceremony will be emceed by Billy Scott and Diane DeVaughn Stokes and promises to be an entertaining few hours.
