




Directions from the Fairfax County Parkway:

Go east until you reach Beulah Rd., cross Beulah and the road changes names to Manchester Blvd. Continue down Manchester (it becomes Kingstown Blvd) for 7 traffic signals. At the 7th traffic signal, turn left on to South Van Dorn St. At the 2nd traffic signal, turn left onto Lake Village Dr. Take an immediate left and the Community Center will be a few buildings down on your right.

Directions from the Beltway:

Exit the Beltway at South Van Dorn St. and proceed south on South Van Dorn St. Cross over Franconia Rd., where you will enter Kingstown, after crossing Franconia Rd., continue on South Van Dorn and turn right at the first traffic signal, on to Lake Village Dr. Then take an immediate left and you will see the Community Center a few buildings down on your right. Roasted Butternut Squash, Bacon and Mushrooms With Pasta

Preparation

Prepare butternut squash: Wash, cut off both ends, cut in half where the neck and round part connect, so you have the top portion and the bottom portion. Cut both of those pieces in half. Scoop out seeds and membrane with a spoon from the bottom section and discard. Peel by cutting down the sides with a sharp knife to peel the tough exterior. Cut into 1" cubes. Line a large baking sheet with aluminum foil and spray with cooking spray. Coat a large casserole dish (11 x 7) with baking spray (I used butter flavored canola spray). Shred the cheese of your choice (see * below), if not already shredded.

Ingredients

3 cups cubed butternut squash	6 slices bacon
1 cup shredded sharp provolone or cheese of your choice	2 cups cleaned, sliced fresh white or brown mushrooms (optional)
1/3 cup Parmesan cheese	1/2 to 1 cup thinly sliced shallots (optional)
1 tablespoon olive oil	8 oz. cooked al dente mini-penne pasta
1/2 tsp. table or sea salt	2 Tablespoons butter
1/2 tsp. dried rosemary, or seasoning of your choice	1/4 cup flour
1/4 tsp. freshly ground black pepper	2 cups 2% reduced-fat milk, or half & half
3+ cups (1-inch) cubed, peeled butternut squash	
Cooking spray	

Directions

Preheat oven to 425 degrees

Combine salt, rosemary/seasoning and pepper. Put cubed squash in extra-large bowl; mix with olive oil; spread on foil lined baking sheet (foil can be sprayed with cooking spray.) Sprinkle top with seasoning. Bake for 45 minutes – check to see if tender and slightly browned. While the squash is baking, cook bacon until medium crispy. Crumble or break bacon in pieces. Leave about a tablespoon of drippings in pan and sauté onions and mushrooms until done. Set aside. Cook pasta to al dente, rinse, drain, and set aside. When squash is done, sprinkle bacon, shallots and mushrooms on top of squash, while still on baking sheet. Set aside.

Turn oven up to 450 degrees.

In a frying pan on medium heat with a little bacon grease in it (optional), add 2 Tbsp. butter. Melt butter, whisk in flour, slowly whisk in milk or half and half; cook until slightly thickened, stirring constantly. Remove from heat, add cheese(s) and stir until cheese is melted. Add pasta to cheese mixture and mix well. Put in prepared casserole dish. Sprinkle top evenly with Parmesan cheese.

Bake at 450 degrees for 10 minutes or until cheese melts and it begins to brown.
