Our Northern Virginia society of shaggers lost a champion June 25th. Dave joined the Northern Virginia Shag Club in 2007. He had been the Treasurer and the Membership Chairman for one year each, and served as President for 3 years. At the time of his death he was still serving on the dance committee, and was Chairman of the ACSC Workshop Committee.

He brought us up to a new level, our membership has grown, we now have a very nice venue for our weekly dances, and Dave convinced the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs to let us host the 2015 ACSC Workshop this month. That alone tells all that Virginia is now a leader in the Carolina Shag world. Thus, Dave brought us pride, and respect among the 100 or so shag clubs in the United States. And, as always, he did it in a humble way, minimizing his exposure as the initiator of ideas and always giving credit to those who helped. He was a pathfinder, and never one to shrink from responsibility. Even in his last moments, his directions to his wife, Angie, were with consideration of the NVSC members. Dave was the epitome of that most crucial leadership principle: Set the example. He did and we will miss him.

And We Have Lost Other Shaggers

The shag world is mourning the passing of two greats: Eddie Monsour and Phil Sawyer. Eddie Monsour and his wife, Kathryn, have been for years the principal financial patrons of Junior Shag, through Junior SOS, sponsoring Junior Divisions at Nationals, Grand Nationals, etc. Eddie and Kathryn were and are truly beloved by generations of Junior Shaggers. Eddie was also the founder and chairman of the Hall of Fame Foundation, a non-profit charitable organization with a shag focus, separate from the Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame, which provides financial assistance to persons in serious need. Phil Sawyer ("Dr. Phil") is considered one of the founders of ACSC and he remained Chairman Emeritus of SOS until his death. He is the author of the book "Save the Last Dance for Me: A Love Story of the Shag and the Society of Strangers". You will hear a great deal more about these two individuals at the ACSC meeting.

Earlier today I received an email from one of Sharon Shipp's sisters, informing me that Sharon died under Hospice care this morning, Sunday June 7, in South Carolina, around 4:00 AM, surrounded by her family. David and Sharon were very active members of the Northern Virginia Shag Club for many years before moving to South Carolina.

When I spoke with Sharon's sister yesterday on the phone, she told me that David Shipp had decided not to have a traditional church service and burial/interment. Instead, David and Sharon's family will be planning a Celebration of her life at some time in the near future. 



Recipe

SWISS CHARD FRITTATA

(4 servings)

- | | | |
|------------------------------|-------------------------------|------------------------------------------------|
| 1 pound Swiss chard, stemmed | 6 eggs | 2 teaspoons chopped fresh thyme, or 1 teaspoon |
| 3 tablespoons olive oil | 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan | dried thyme |
| 1 onion, thinly sliced | Pinch of nutmeg | 1/2 teaspoon salt |
| | | Black pepper to taste |

Preheat broiler. Place the chard in a saucepan without the addition of any more water than the drops still clinging to the leaves from washing. Cover and cook over medium heat until the leaves wilt and are tender, just a few minutes. Remove from heat and let cool. Then squeeze out as much water as possible. Chop coarsely and set aside. In a small skillet over medium-low heat, warm 1 tablespoon of olive oil. Add the onion and sauté until golden, 6 to 8 minutes. Remove from the heat and let cool slightly. In a bowl, beat the eggs lightly, then beat in the cheese, nutmeg, thyme, salt and pepper. Stir in the chard and onion. Pour the remaining 2 tablespoons of olive oil into a 12-inch skillet and place over medium heat. When it is hot enough, add the egg mixture and distribute the solid items evenly with a fork. Reduce the heat to low and cook it until the mixture is set but not browned. Do not overcook the mixture. Put the pan under the broiler until the top is golden. Remove the frittata to a warm serving plate and cut into serving wedges.
