Why our 2006 Christmas Party ended Early by Tom Brett

The Christmas party on December 16th was terminated about 40 minutes early by Ft Myer civilian employees who **failed to read the contract** to learn our **"end"** time and discourteously broke up the party early. In the few minutes it took for NVSC board members to get to the office, cause the employees to find their contract copy showing the 12:30 AM "end" time and reach agreement, the fast -working NVSC people had ceiling lights on, tables and chairs being stacked, etc. The disruption had stopped the party early.

I met with Ft Myer officials to lodge a complaint about the behavior of their employees, to request an apology to NVSC and to request a partial refund.

They were quite fair and willing to compromise; the meeting results were that NVSC received:

- 1. a formal written apology from Ft. Myer,
- 2. a refund of \$170 toward our 8 Dec. '07 Christmas party [which will cover our 2d, 3d & 4th hours and kitchen rental],
- 3. or, a cash refund of \$120, if no future events were to be held at Ft. Myer,
- 4. the two employees were disciplined.


