



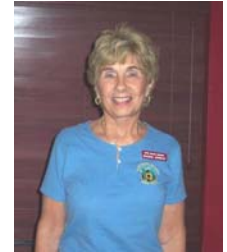

BOARD NOTES

1. It has been suggested that the notification for annual dues be sent by email and sent only by regular mail to members that would like to have the dues notification mailed to them. 3. Marcia Conway represented the club at the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs workshop/party in Jacksonville, Florida. This summer workshop and the winter workshop that was held in Danville, VA in February are mandatory meetings and clubs must send a representative to maintain good standing in the ACSC.

Here are some of the highlights of the workshop:

- Note of appreciation from the American Red Cross for the \$10,000 donation to help out the victims of the fire at Conway, SC and surrounding areas during Spring SOS.
- It was reported that 1,000 people participated in the parade at spring SOS. The theme for the 2010 Spring SOS is “Sweet Sixteen”.
- Clubs were asked to remind members that umbrellas, small tents, golf carts and coolers are not allowed on Main Street during the Fun Monday Concerts.
- A total of 9,373 SOS cards have been sold.
- Detailed reports were presented by the ACSC Chairman, the Vice-Chairman and the SOS President as to how the ACSC and SOS were started.
- All clubs will receive a reimbursement of \$400 for ACSC workshop expenses.
- The lighting ceremony of the water tower with the shag dancers will be on Saturday, September 12th at 8:30PM. Main Street will be closed off during that time.
