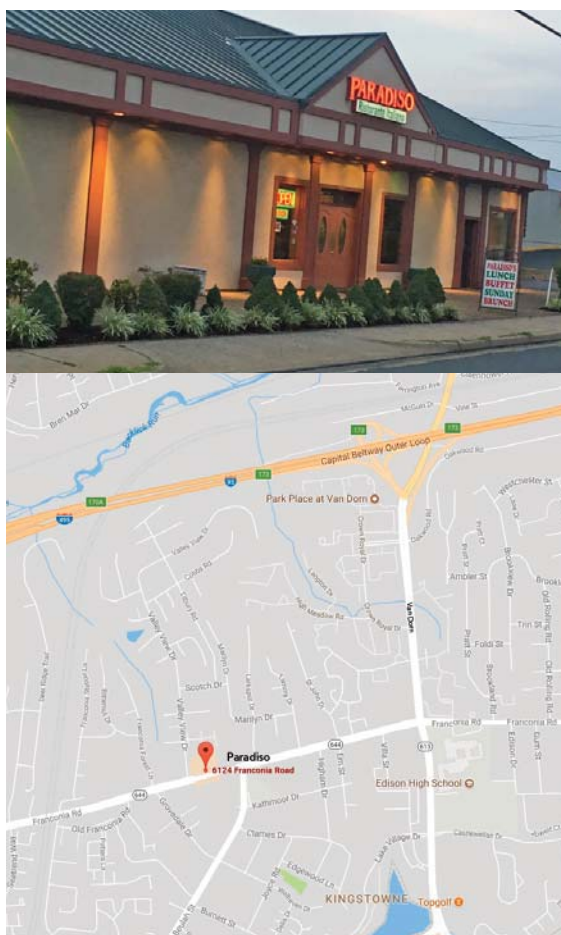

## Fab FUNdraising 2017!

**A**s chairperson, I would like to give special thanks to everyone who participated in any and all ways in the 19th Annual NVSC Shag-A-Thon plus the 2nd Annual Wine Tasting fundraisers in support of Capital Caring! Your support makes it possible to give families assistance during difficult times. I've pulled excerpts from several of last year's "Hello Shagger" emails that I hope you find interesting:

### Did you know...

- According to the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization website (<http://www.nhpc.org/about/hospice-care>), the medieval concept of hospice was a place for weary or ill travelers to find rest and shelter.
- Physician Dame Cicely Saunders started providing specialized care for dying patients in **1948** and is credited with starting the first hospice in a suburb of London. For the US, it wasn't until **1993** when President Clinton's health care reform made hospice a nationally guaranteed benefit.
- **2004:** More than 1 million Americans with a life-limiting illness were served by the nation's hospices in 2004, the first time the million-person mark has been crossed.
- **2005:** The number of hospice provider organizations throughout the country tops 4,000 for the first time.
- **2006:** Dame Cecily Saunders dies and a celebration of her life is held in Westminster Abbey on March 8; the U.S. hospice community issues a resolution honoring Dame Cecily.
- **2009:** The number of hospice volunteers continues to grow with a record 550,000 people serving as volunteers.
- **2014:** Forty years after the creation of Connecticut Hospice, NHPCO and its affiliates celebrate 40 years of hospice care in the US.

### Did you know...

NVSC adopted the Capital Caring hospice group for our charity fundraising benefactor early in the clubs infancy? In 1998, Vesta Jones got members to

donate 45s and 33s to be used as table decorations. For a donation, club members had their names added in glitter. The "Go On Record for Charity" activity was born. Heather Jennings sparked the idea of having a Shag-A-Thon to raise money and our first annual Shag-A-Thon was held Feb 6, 1999 at Macy's Court in the Springfield Mall with over 60 members and guests participating in the event and collecting over \$8,000. The combined charity efforts in 1999 netted \$12,000 for hospice. Quite an impressive effort. Today, the NVSC annual Shag-A-Thon is one of several activities that the club uses to collect donations for this great cause.

**T**he celebration of the CBMA Awards (originally called the Cammys for Carolina's Magic Music Years) began in 1995 as an exciting party of performers and fans of Carolina Beach Music. Fourteen bands entertained at the first awards show held in Salisbury, NC. Those in attendance will never forget the memorable event.

Charlotte, NC was home to the CBMAs for the next two years as the awards show continued to grow in size, scope and quality.

In 1998 the CBMAs moved to North Myrtle Beach, SC and the CBMA Weekend was born.

During this festive weekend, entertainers perform at various beach clubs on both Friday and Saturday nights. A "Band Fair" is held prior to the awards show on Sunday afternoon. The Hayes Jewelers VIP Party after the awards event, continues to be a tradition.

The mission of the CBMA Awards is to promote Carolina Beach Music, its influences and offshoots and the unique Carolina lifestyle by the presentation of a first class awards show that originates each November in North Myrtle Beach, SC. The show honors winners in various categories and remembers the pioneers who originated this music and helped make it great. Those honored are performers, songwriters, radio personalities, mobile DJ's, dancers, producers, engineers, promoters and others who have been integrally involved with the music's success. The further overall purpose is to keep this music alive by getting young people involved in this fun yet clean cut music, to give the music its deserved recognition, respect and

credibility, and to bring diverse people together in an upbeat harmonious manner.

The CBMA Awards have become an icon of Carolina Beach Music and the home of this southern tradition.

## Shake off those cold weather Blues!

# SOS continues even in the cold months!

**MID WINTERS SOS, January 11-14, 2018.**

**Requires a 2018 SOS card for free entry into the beach clubs [see NVSC Treasurer for your 2018 card in case Santa didn't slip one into your stocking)**

**Y**es, the party goes on... drinking, dancing, meeting up with old friends, dancing, drinking, making new friends, drinking, dance lessons (Fat Harold's, with Judy Duke), going to the beach clubs, dancing, just like April and September days (and nights!) of sore foot, knee weary, bleary-eyed bliss. But compressed into a Thursday noon–Sunday mornin', 4-day, time frame. A few years ago, ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Clubs, the business side of the house, and what keeps our SOS going and growing) combined Mid Winters SOS with the mandatory Winter Workshop (for all ACSC Club Presidents/Representatives).

### **Advantages, and a few Disadvantages of January SOS**

Fewer people, more room on the dance floors, even in the evenings; cold drinks stay cold longer; free facials every time you walk on Ocean Boulevard (from salty breezes and sand); lower rates at most lodging; fewer people everywhere in NMB and surrounding areas — you can get into those places you wanted to visit or eat without much of a (or any) line; unhappily, Hoskins Family Restaurant customarily is closed for the winter season; no one looks at you for drinking coffee before the 4th drink on those chilly nights; sunsets are even more spectacular, if that's possible; you can hear the music better (cold air carries sound waves more clearly); sunburns are still possible to keep your face glowing; no lying out on the beach; if you do find yourself lying out on the beach you've definitely had too much fun, and folks will probably step over you

(unlike warm seasons where kind hearted folks wake you up to tell you what degree of fried you are); Junior Shaggers competition Saturday night\*; it's been warm enough for the hearty (and hardy) golfers to play a round or two; it's been cold enough to send even the most die hard shagger in search of a real winter coat to wear between clubs and getting back home for the night; jackets/sweaters/most outer layer "reserves" your seat while you're dancing.

Never been to SOS before? Mid Winters is a GREAT way to "break in" to the shag culture-lifestyle-madness-happiness that overtakes thousands (YES, thousands!) of us primarily 55+ each April and September. Attendance in January is usually in the low thousands (as in, 3,200 vs. 12,100 April/Sept) on the busy weekend nights — still sounds like a lot, but trust me, in January you can get to the bar and back without spilling your drink over happy shaggers everywhere. Of course, if you spill your drink on a shagger in January, they're not going to be as happy about it. But still... in January you can SEE the dance floor in each of the clubs, well, except for when Jim Quick & Coastline play in the front room at Fat Harold's. DJs are in all of the beach clubs, noon 'til ? on Thurs, Fri, Sat and are going to keep those dance floors filled (helps to keep warm, too, and avoid the drafts of doors opening and closing), prepping for their DJ Throwdown in late Feb/first of March, but that's a whole 'nother adventure!

*\*Personal Disclaimer: the Shad Alberty Memorial Classic is held each year, Saturday night of Mid Winters, in OD Resort Ballroom, hosted by Sam and Lisa West. This is comprised of 2-4 levels of Juniors (depending on participations), prize money is given out, and the Shad Alberty Memorial Scholarship award is announced. If you want to feel good about the future of our dance, be there!*

**The ACSC Winter Workshop business meeting is held on Saturday morning during Mid Winters, beginning at 10am, at OD Resort, the host hotel for Mid Winters.**
